


Earn ABOS Self-Assessment Examination Credits through American Spine Registry (ASR) Participation

As part of its wide variety of data reuse initiatives, the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons (AAOS) Registry Program provides ASR surgeons the opportunity to earn up to 10 self-assessment examination (SAE) credits for the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery (ABOS) Maintenance of Certification (MOC) Part II for each year of participation in the Registry.

Steps to attain SAE Credit:

- 1. Participate in ASR
 - Your hospital, health system, ambulatory surgery centers (ASC), or practice needs to be contracted with ASR and actively submitting data on your behalf (active = at least quarterly)
- 2. Create a Surgeon Authorized User account
 - Reach out to your site's Registry Authorized User to be added or contact Info@AmericanSpineRegistry.org
- 3. Login to the RegistryInsights® platform
 - You have access to view your data and download your MOC certificate at any time via the Surgeon Dashboard on RegistryInsights



- 4. Select "Print MOC Coversheet"
 - Navigate to the yellow button at the top right of the page
 - o Select "ABOS" for the letter type and the year to run your report
- 5. Email your MOC certificate to AAOS Registries staff
 - Send to <u>Info@AmericanSpineRegistry.org</u> and state which year you are seeking credit for
 - An AAOS Registries team member will validate your participation in the registry and record the credits in your MyAAOS portal for submission to ABOS
 - Separate certificates are needed for each year you are interested in receiving credit
